**Sub: Dr. NTRVST- P&C-Reservation of 133 procedures under Aarogya Raksha and mapping of 123 procedures for Private Teaching Institutions- Circular issued- Reg**

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
It is to inform that the Government has launched the Aarogya Raksha Scheme for APL families on 01/01/2017 to be implemented as per the guidelines of Dr. NTR Vaidya Seva scheme. In this regard, there are 133 procedures reserved for Government institutions in Dr. NTRVS, Further the Private Teaching Institutions have requested the Government to map 133 reserved procedures to the hospitals so as to provide necessary practical exposure to the Post Graduate students.

Hence it is decided the following modifications for implementation in Dr. NTRVS and Aarogya Raksha Schemes:

1. All 133 reserved procedures reserved for Government shall be blocked for private hospitals as in NTRVS.
2. All Private teaching hospitals shall be allowed to perform 123 procedures leaving the top performing 10 procedures of 133 procedures with a cap of 40 pre-authorisations per month.
3. For all Government Institutions and teaching hospitals, all the 1044 procedures shall be made available as per the existing guidelines.

Hence all NWHs are hereby informed that the above modifications will come into effect from **08.06.2018**. All the NWHs are requested to note the above and act accordingly while registering the beneficiaries.
